CNA II

The CNA II course consists of 36 hours and will take place over 5 weeks. There is not a state or national licensing exam for the CNA II, but each facility must verify that the employee can perform 21 specific clinical competencies a minimum of two times. Successful completion of this program is required before a student can progress to training as a Medication Assistant-Certified (MA-C). The Wyoming State Board of Nursing established curriculum standards for Level II Certified Nursing Assistant Training in compliance with Chapter 7, Sections 10-12 of the WSNB Administrative Rules and Regulations. The CNA II training enhances and broadens the scope of practice for the CNA to include eleven additional skills. After

proving competency in these skills, the student is recognized as a CNA II by the Wyoming State Board of Nursing.

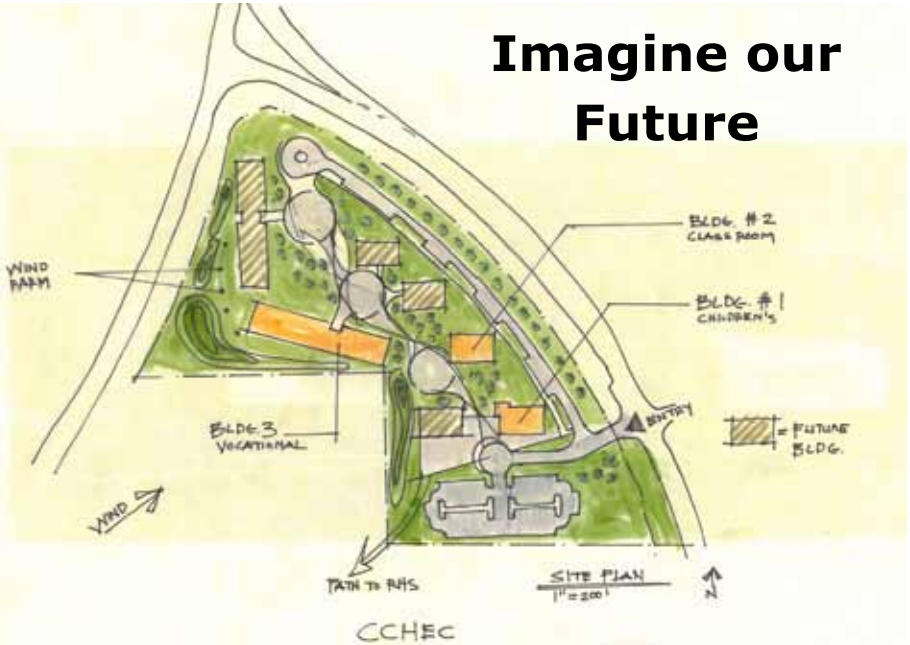
