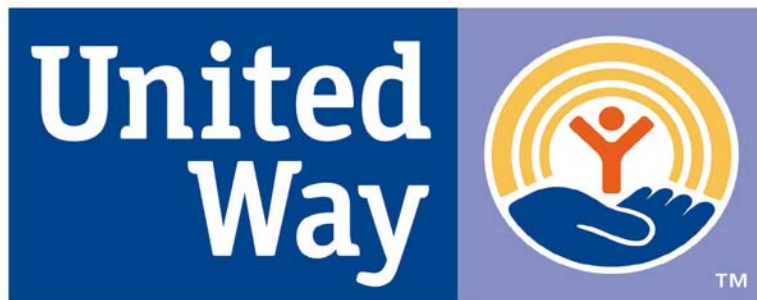

Organization Info: Multipurpose human service agency providing assistance to individuals with limited income and resources in food stamps, childcare, or nursing home care. The TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) program provides short – term financial assistance for families in need with dependent children. Parents and sometimes children receiving TANF must participate in the POWER (Personal Opportunities with Employment Responsibilities) program. The Telephone Assistance Plan can reduce the phone bill of qualified households. Eligibility is based upon income. Social services provided for children and or adults at risk of abuse or neglect without regard to financial situation including counseling, adoption, foster care, crisis intervention, preventive day care, emergency shelter, residential treatment for children, and investigations of abuse and child support failure. Youth services include working with families where behaviors place youth at risk of delinquency including CHINS (Children in need of Supervision) or youth on juvenile probation.
