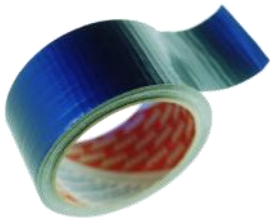
LEGO Mechanics

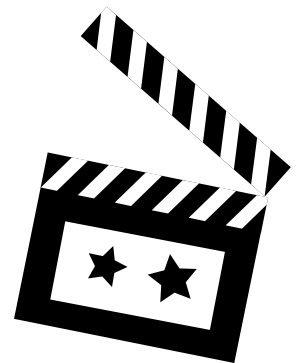
Pinocchio-Children's Theatre Camp
